ONLINE EXAM INSTRUCTIONS

- **Students are advised to recharge their internet data pack for at least 6 days, the amount will be refunded after depositing the recharge bill to the university.**
- Students are advised to download the Google Chrome browser, and then open the Incognito window (Ctrl+Shift+N) to begin the test.
- **To begin the exam, click on the link <http://onlineexam.dbranlu.ac.in>.**
- **Students will not use keywords throughout the exam.**
- The student may not use his or her textbook, course notes, or any supporting material from external sources.
- Students must not stop the session and then return to it. This is especially important in the online environment where the system will "time-out" and not allow the student or you to reenter the exam site.
- **The clock has been set at the server and the countdown timer at the top-right corner of your screen will display the time remaining for you to complete the test.**
- Our primary & backup servers will be active for the exam period. In case there are issues such as interruption or disconnection it would be at student's end and not the exam server.
- If the test ends abruptly due to power failure, problem with internet connection or any other reason, the online test session will be disabled and you cannot continue further.
- Students are advised to use fast, reliable, and stable internet connection. If a student lacks relevant computer/network knowledge please consult with a friend or family member who can assist in this regard.
- **It is mandatory to have a functional webcam and students must allow permission to access their webcams prior to commencement of the test.**
- **Students may not peek elsewhere apart from their screens and may not take breaks. Each student shall be proctored vigilantly and would be disqualified if found availing unfair means in any way.**
- **Students are informed to be cautious with the test window that opens after starting the test. It must not be resized, minimized, or obscured in any manner.
